Ambassador Zorica Marić-Djordjević is a Senior Peace Fellow at PILPG. Her career in public service and diplomacy spans 40 years. Amb. Marić-Djordjević was the Head of the Permanent Mission of Montenegro to the World Trade Organization and Special Representative of Montenegro to the UN Human Rights Council 2013-2015. She has held leadership positions, including Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of Montenegro and the Chief Policy Advisor to the Prime Minister. She served as the Special Envoy of the Prime Minister and President of Montenegro to the US and the Head of Montenegro Trade Mission in Washington, DC. She was responsible for coordinating USAID assistance and was the liaison to the US Congress, State Department, and the Pentagon for the Government of Montenegro. Through these positions, Amb. Marić-Djordjević made a case for Montenegro's independence and its membership in NATO. She participated in NDI/UN peacebuilding mission in Sierra Leone in 2007 and led the PILPG Mission in South Sudan in 2010. After retiring from diplomatic service in May 2020, she joined the WTO experts' network on Trade for Peace as an independent consultant. She continues to advocate on issues of transitional justice, human rights, and empowerment of women. She is a visiting speaker at El Colegio de Mexico, Guillermo Aguilar Alvarez – Program in International Trade Negotiation for 2021.
