

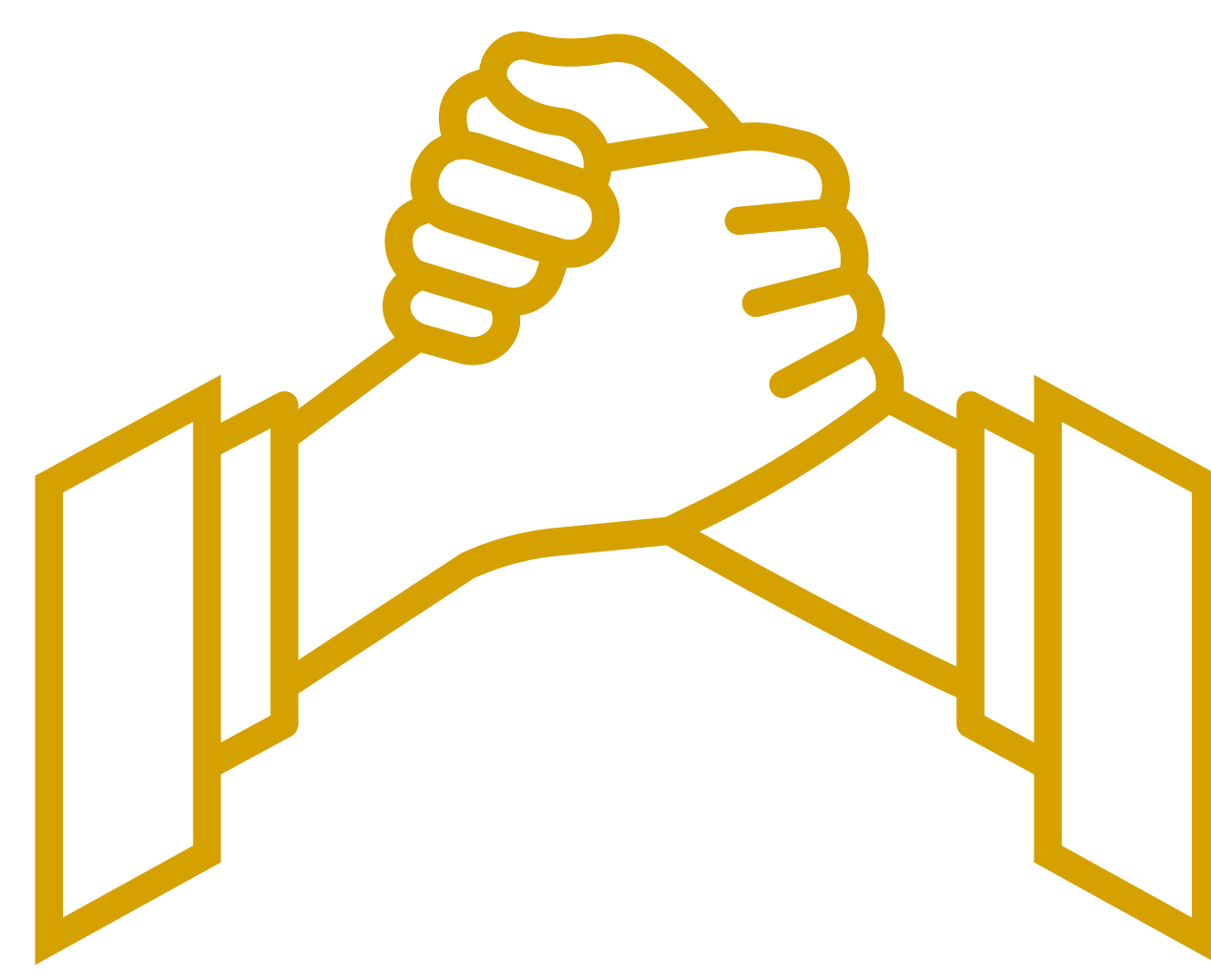


TRADE IN FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS IMPROVES FOOD SECURITY.



'Correct and prevent trade restrictions and distortions in world agricultural markets':

The WTO Agreement on Agriculture plays an instrumental role in addressing restrictions and distortions in agricultural markets and remains the bedrock for domestic policy reforms towards this objective.



Exemption of export prohibitions or restrictions on purchases by the World Food Programme:

WTO members agreed at the 12th WTO Ministerial Conference (MC12) to not impose export prohibitions or restrictions on foodstuffs purchased for non-commercial humanitarian purposes by the World Food Programme.



Ministerial declaration on the emergency response to food insecurity:

WTO members adopted at MC12 a declaration stating that trade – along with domestic production – plays a vital role in improving global food security and committed to improve the functioning and longterm resilience of global markets for food and agriculture.
