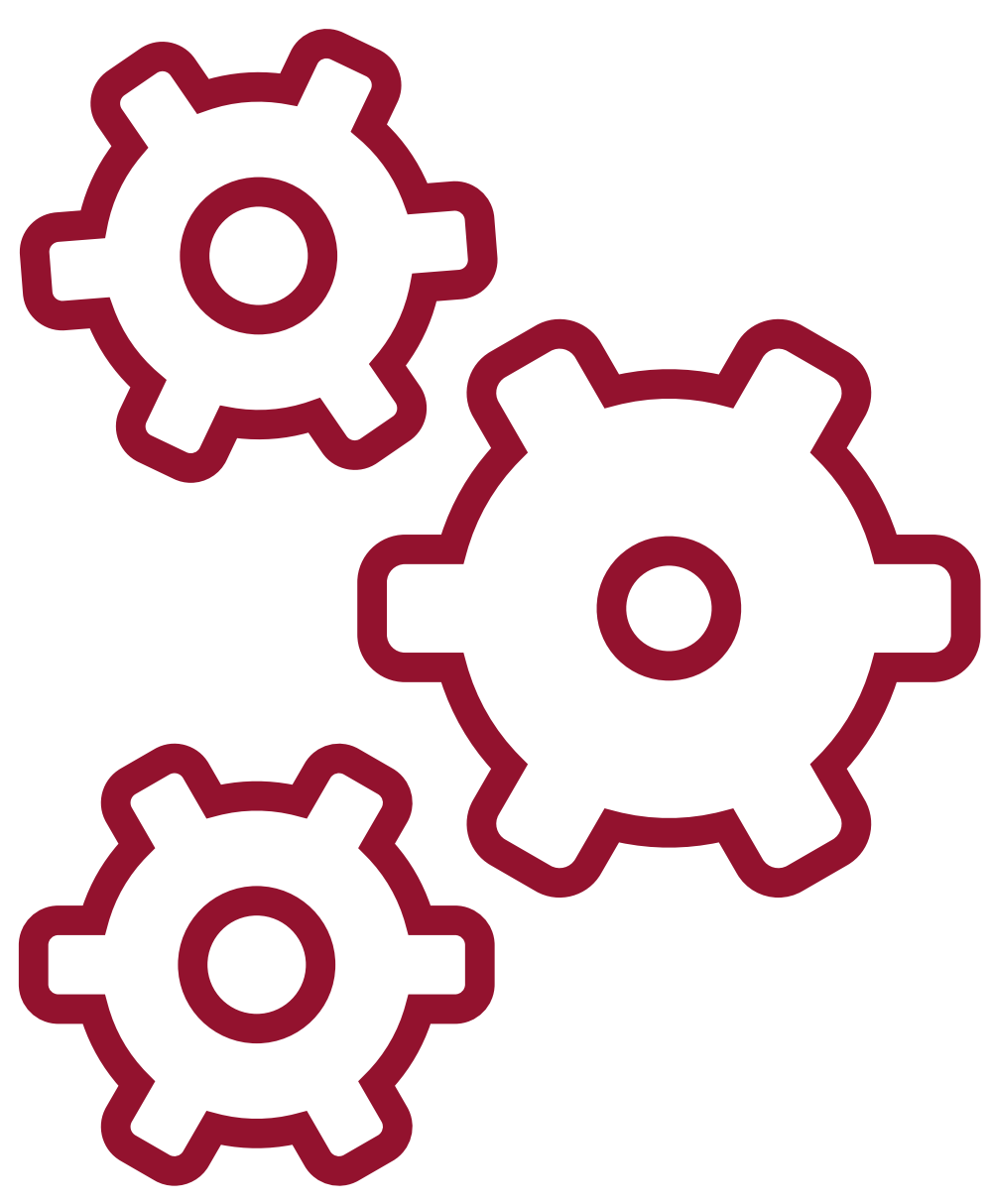

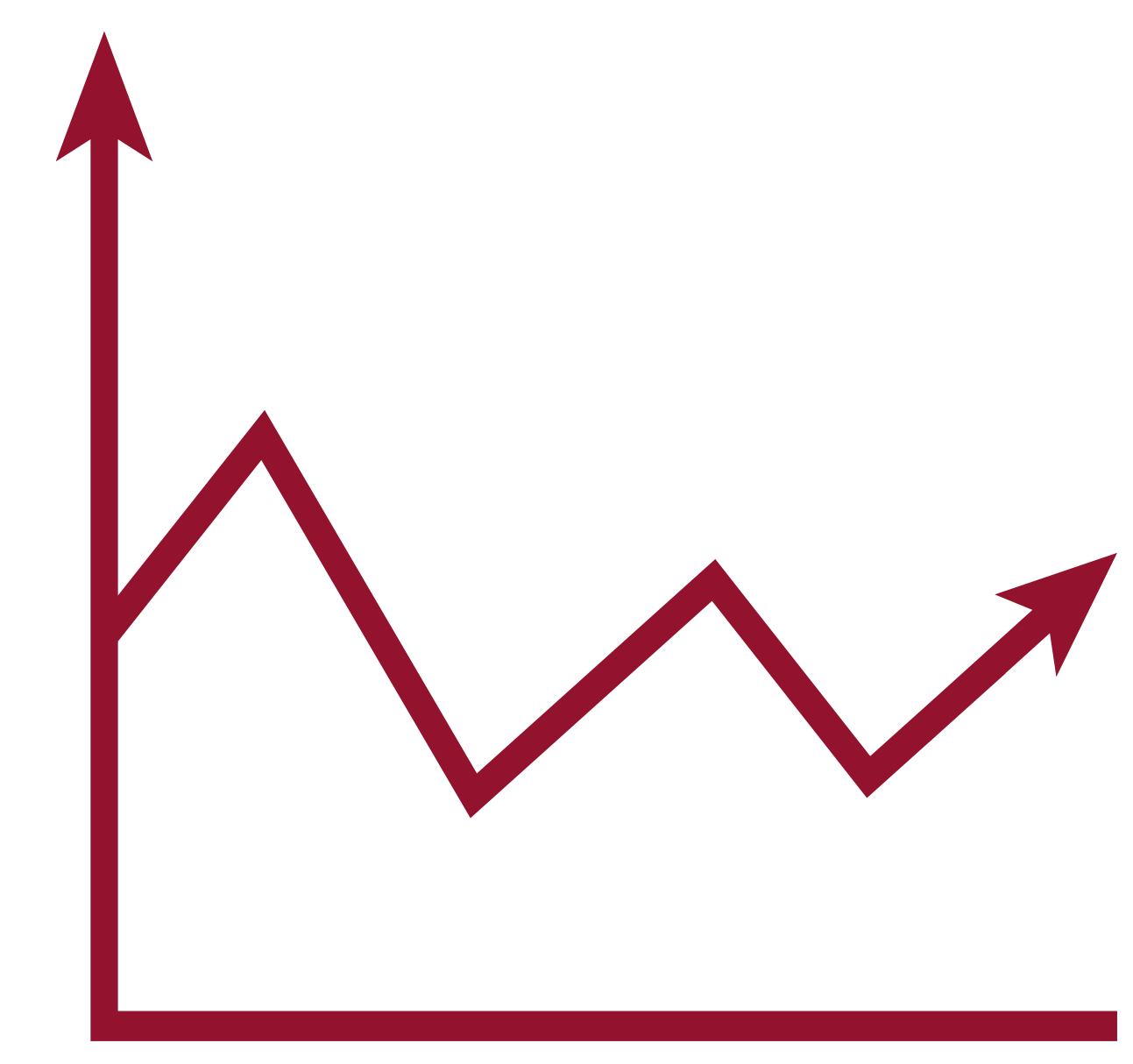


Trade encourages competition and the spread of new technologies and leads to growth, development and job creation. **For more than 25 years, the WTO rules-based multilateral trading system has fostered stable, predictable and equitable trading relations.**



**The WTO's Aid for Trade initiative helps developing and least developed countries (LDCs) benefit from international trade.**

The initiative complements domestic efforts in building trade capacity by enhancing their infrastructure and improving their ability to trade.



**This SDG calls specifically for countries to increase Aid for Trade support for developing countries and, in particular, LDCs.** Some 30% of Aid for Trade disbursements since 2006 have gone to LDCs, amounting to \$152 billion. In 2020, LDCs received \$13.2 billion, the highest amount of disbursements per capita.
