

Overall implementation of trade facilitation measures in 44 Asia-Pacific countries, 2017












Biosecurity clearance with Risk Management



Overall implementation of trade facilitation measures in 46 Asia-Pacific countries, 2021






Power consumption unfazed – Government data Centre




