 Regulatory (SPS/TBT) requirements significant share of all nontariff measures

"Technical Barriers to Trade are the most frequent form of NTMs, affecting 35 per cent of product lines and about 65 per cent of world trade, followed by export measures and sanitary and

phytosanitary measures."






