2) Investment Subsidies	Credit Concessions	Measure is aimed at reducing production costs and encouraging farmers to be less reliant on 'out-right' subsidies'. Concessionary credit is also provided to promote innovations on agricultural practices, promote productivity improvements, hence increasing production and income. Credit concessions are limited to smallholders.	M\$ 5.4 million	Federal Budget Estimates, 1986-89.
