ILLUSTRATIVE¹ MOCK EXAMPLES OF NOTIFICATIONS UNDER ARTICLE 6.2

Case 1: The Member has no trade-related investment measures in place, nor any intention of introducing them

A simple communication stating this fact is sufficient.

EXAMPLE:

"With reference to Article 6.2 of the TRIMs Agreement, the Government of [name of the Member] wishes to notify the WTO Secretariat that [name of the Member] does not maintain or intend to introduce any trade-related investment measures for the time being and, accordingly, does not have any publication in this regard."

Case 2: The Member has no specific mechanism for the publication of trade-related investment measures. All laws and regulations, including those concerning investment, are published in an official gazette or journal

A communication stating this fact is sufficient.

EXAMPLE:

"Pursuant to Article 6.2 of the Agreement on Trade-Related Investment Measures, the Government of [name of the Member] wishes to notify the WTO Secretariat that [name of the Member] has no specific mechanism for the publication of trade-related investment measures. All national laws, decrees and regulatory measures are published in the Official Gazette [name of the publication]. This publication can be found at the following internet address: [electronic address of the publication, if any] Regional/state/local governments have similar instruments for the publication of their legal acts. [Name of the publications, if available]."
