Likewise, purchases of land by foreign legal persons or enterprises are limited to 5,000 m². Above this limit, authorization in the form of a presidential decree is required. All foreign companies must recruit a minimum of 80 per cent of Dominican employees. In special circumstances, the employment of more foreigners may be authorized when it is hard or impossible to replace them by Dominicans, with the obligation for the company to train Dominican staff.</p>
