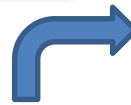

Regional Efforts in Promoting Harmonized Food Safety Regulation in a Period of Change and Innovation



- Harmonization of food safety standards has been developed for trade facilitation and eliminating Technical Barrier to Trade (TBT)
- The principles of Harmonization of food safety standards in ASEAN :
 - 1) Codex standards as the reference;
 - 2) In the absence of Codex standards → using applicable international or regional standards;
 - 3) shall not compromise food safety and public health; and
 - 4) Regulatory mechanisms and infrastructure shall be in place to monitor compliance of harmonization.
