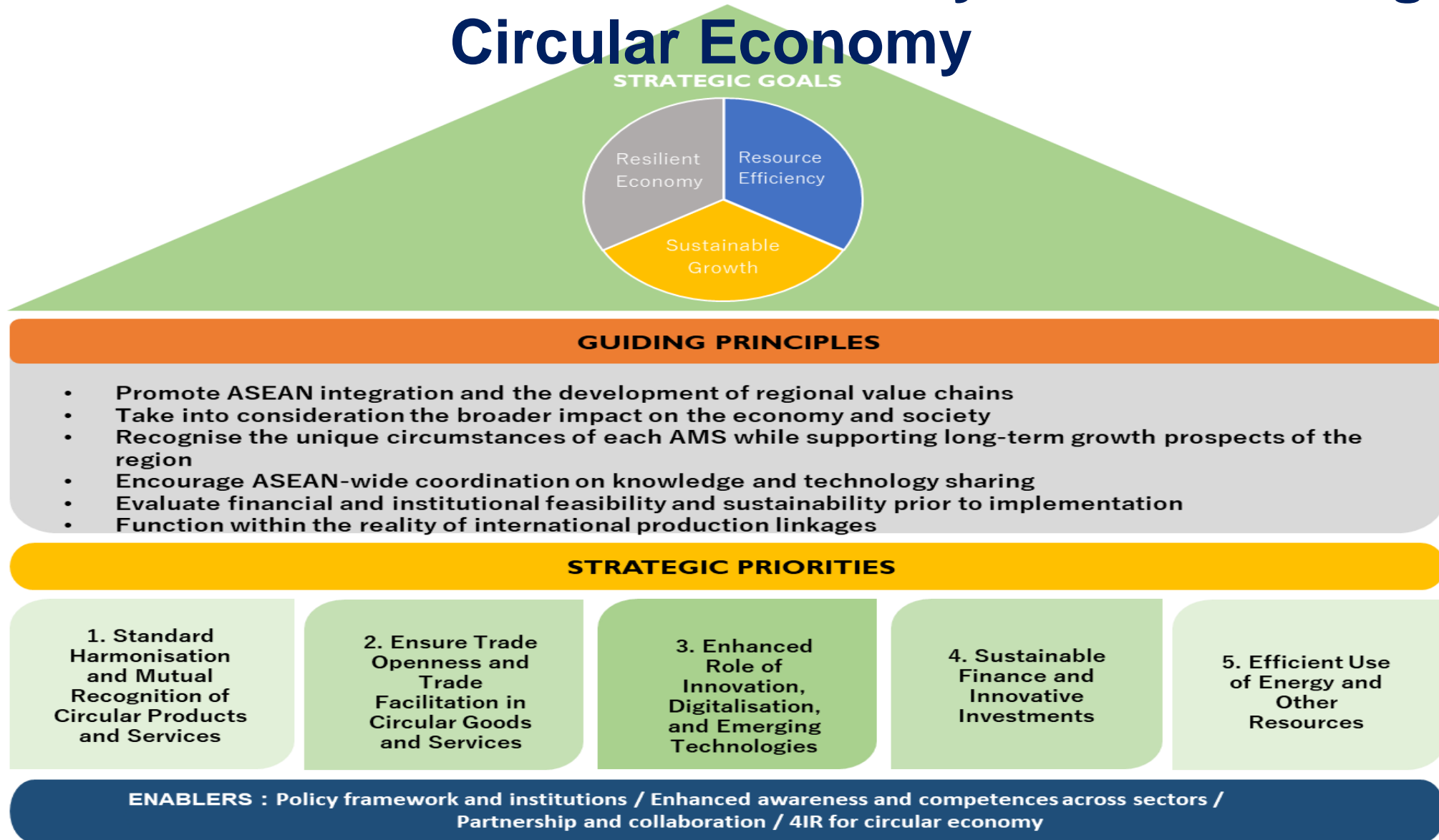

Focus is on Capacity Building



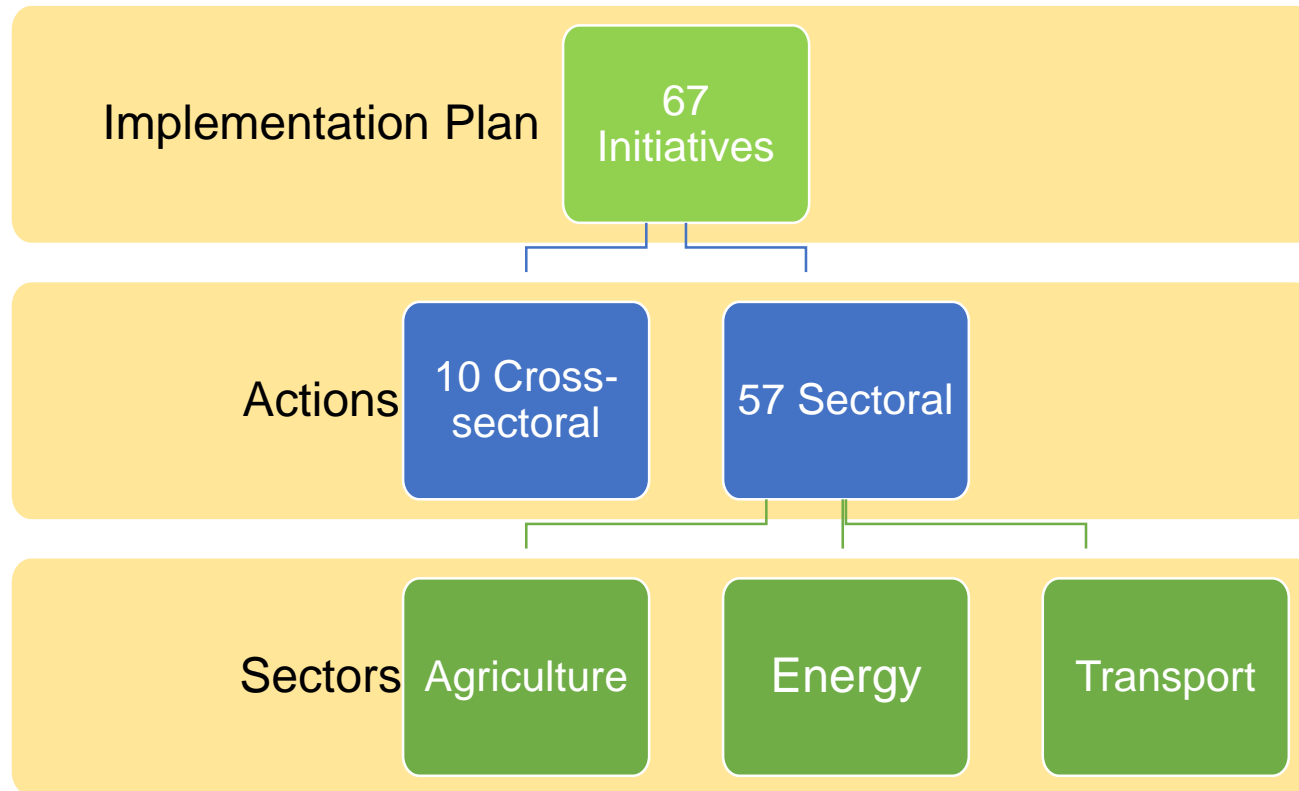
Applicable to all sectors, covering 5 components

SP1: Standards harmonisation and mutual recognition of circular products and services

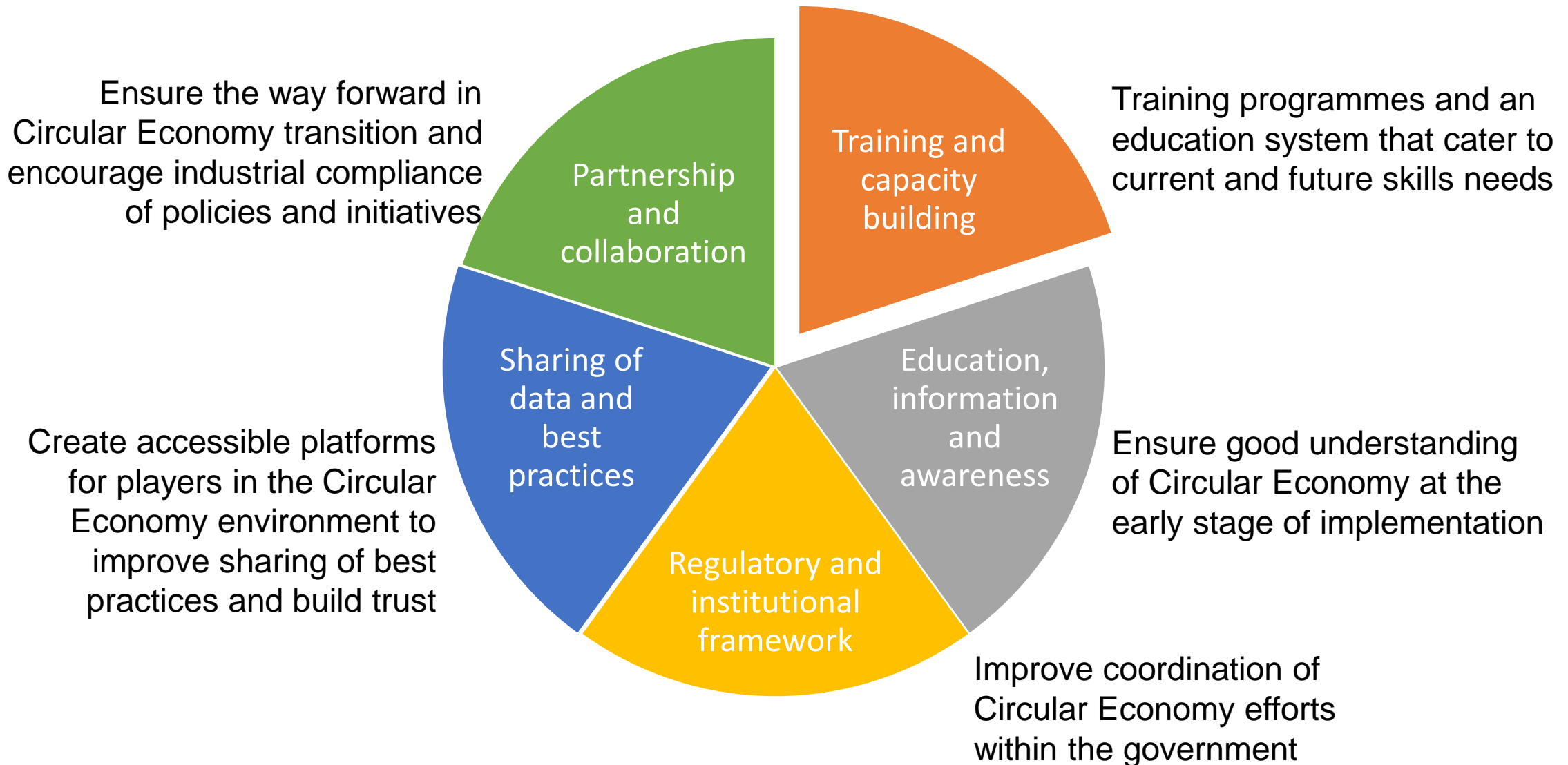
SP2: Ensure trade openness and trade facilitation in goods and services
