TESSD HIGH-LEVEL STOCKTAKING EVENT

In December 2021, Co-sponsors of the Trade and Environmental Sustainability Structured Discussions (TESSD) launched a Ministerial Statement (WT/MIN(21)/6/Rev.2) recognizing that international trade and trade policy must support environmental and climate goals and agreeing to work towards concrete actions to expand opportunities for environmentally sustainable trade. In 2022, Co-sponsors agreed on a TESSD Work Plan and advanced discussions in plenary sessions as well as in four working groups on trade-related climate measures, environmental goods and services, circular economy – circularity and subsidies.

The objective of this high-level event is to take stock on progress made in discussions since the launch of the TESSD Ministerial Statement, as well as to signal priorities for the work going forward towards MC13.
