



Dr. Henrietta N. Ukwu, M.D., FACP, FRAPS, is a physician, infectious diseases expert, professor, pharmaceutical industry executive, thought leader, and published author in the fields of Regulatory Affairs and leadership including the landmark textbook, *Global Regulatory Systems – A Strategic Primer for Biopharmaceutical Product Development and Registration* and recent ABCs of leadership book.
