Christian Piaget is Head, Cargo Border Management at the International Air Transport Association (IATA), where he is responsible to monitor, develop and ensure compliance with customs security laws impacting air cargo movements, as well as related international standards on customs risk management and trade facilitation.

After a Master in law in Switzerland and an MA in European Studies in Belgium, Christian started his career in 1997 at the International Road Transport Union in Geneva. For 10 years he has carried out several legal and lobbying activities relating to road transport, culminating with the direction of the Legal department and the External affairs.

Then his occupation shifted from road to maritime transport. Based in Brussels, he acted as the EU representative for the World Shipping Council, the lobby association for liner shipping companies. His main tasks focused on customs matters, actively contributing to the development of customs rules and standards for the movement of goods at the EU Commission and the World Customs Organisation.

Christian joined IATA in May 2013 to work on the development and ongoing maintenance of the cargo customs and claims procedures and standards. He is now in charge of promoting the interests of air cargo, with a specialization in customs matters, security and trade facilitation. In the IATA governance, Christian is the Secretary of the IATA Cargo Border Management Board and the Cargo Customs Working Group. He has also an IATA International Air Law Diploma and is organizing every year the IATA Cargo Claims & Loss Prevention Conference.
