RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTS FROM ROMANIA

Notifications by Contracting Parties

In airgram GATT/AIR/2084 of 23 November 1984, contracting parties were invited to notify by 30 January 1985, in accordance with paragraph 3(b) of the Protocol for the Accession of Romania, discriminatory prohibitions and quantitative restrictions still applied to imports from Romania.

Contracting parties which have not yet submitted notifications are invited to do so without delay. Further notifications will be reproduced in addenda to this document.

AUSTRIA

With reference to document GATT/AIR/2084 I have the honour to inform you that Austria does not apply any discriminatory prohibitions and quantitative restrictions to imports from Romania.

HUNGARY

Referring to GATT/AIR/2084 dated 23 November 1984, I have the honour to communicate that Hungary does not apply any discriminatory prohibitions or quantitative restrictions to imports from Romania.

MALAWI

Reference is made to your airgram GATT/AIR/2084 of 23 November 1984, requesting GATT Contracting Parties to submit by 30 January 1985 notifications on restrictions and/or prohibitions they maintain on imports from Romania that will serve as a basis for the fifth consultations with Romania which are to take place in January next year.

I wish to advise that Malawi does not maintain any type of restrictions, i.e. import quotas, licensing systems, embargoes, etc., on imports from Romania.

NEW ZEALAND

In response to GATT/AIR/2084, I can confirm that New Zealand does not maintain any discriminatory restrictions on imports from Romania.

PAKISTAN

I have the honour to refer to the GATT secretariat's letter No. GATT/AIR/2084 dated 23 November 1984 on the subject noted above and to say that the Government of Pakistan has not imposed any discriminatory prohibitions and quantitative restrictions in case of imports from and exports to Romania.

UNITED STATES

This notification is in response to GATT/AIR/2084 of 23 November 1984.

In conformity with the provisions of Article XIII of the General Agreement, and paragraph 3(a) of the Romanian Protocol of Accession, the United States does not maintain any discriminatory prohibitions or quantitative restrictions on imports from Romania.
