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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Bilateral Arrangement Between Canada and Japan

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Canadian mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

The Government of Japan has agreed to restrain its exports of the following textile products to Canada in 1971:

Item	Fibre	Quantity
Woven blouses	Cotton	240,855 dozen
Woven blouses	Polyester/cotton	47,256 dozen
Woven shirts (all types)	Cotton and/or man- made fibre	413,633 dozen
Woven trousers and outer shorts	Cotton and/or man- made fibre ¹	284,498 dozen

¹ Each of the restraints on shirts, cotton blouses, polyester cotton blouses, and trousers may individually be increased by not more than 10 per cent by transfer among the four restraints. However, total shipments under the four restraints may not exceed the sum of the restraints and possible carry-in and carry-over thereof.

Item	Fibre	Quantity
Pillowcases	Cotton and polyester/cotton	270,204 dozen
Sheets	Cotton and polyester/cotton	1,184,838 pieces

Note: Either of the quotas for pillowcases or sheets may be increased by not more than 10 per cent by transfer from the other quota, using the following conversion ratio:

Pillowcases	1 dozen - 13.008 square yards	
Sheets	1 piece - 6.200 square yards	
Elastic braid	All textile fibres	669,886 pounds

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With regard to cotton and/or man-made fibre textile products,

- (1) - shipments under the quotas may be increased by not more than 5 per cent in 1971, with equivalent reductions in shipments under the corresponding quotas for 1972; and
- (2) - shipments under the quotas for 1971 may be increased by not more than 5 per cent, should shipments in 1970 fall short of the corresponding quotas by equivalent amounts.

During the calendar year 1970 Japan had agreed to limit exports of the following cotton textile items to Canada:

Fabrics	34,298,700 square yards

Elastic braid (all textile fibres)	650,375 pounds
