FRENCH IMPORT RESTRICTIONS

1. The Government of France has transmitted the text of a Notice to Importers relating to imports from the member countries of the OEEC, Canada and the United States, which was published in Journal Officiel No. 304 of 31 December 1960. Essentially this Notice contains a list of products the import of which from the above mentioned countries is subject to licensing restriction. This replaces the previous list contained in Journal Officiel No. 223 of 24 September 1960.
2. The text of the Notice is reproduced in the following pages.

NOTICE TO IMPORTERS OF PRODUCTS ORIGINATING IN AND COMING FROM
MEMBERS OF THE ORGANIZATION FOR EUROPEAN ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION,
THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA

TRADE LIBERALIZATION

As from 1 January 1961 all quantitative restrictions are lifted on imports of products originating in and coming from members of the Organization for European Economic Co-operation (OEEC), the United States and Canada, other than those listed in Annex I to this notice.

Furthermore, products listed in Annex I and marked with an asterisk (*) shall be liberalized when originating in and coming from OEEC countries.

However, quantitative import restrictions shall be maintained in respect of some products which are not listed in Annex I, when such products originate in Hong Kong. Such products are listed in Annex II to this notice.

The elimination of the above quantitative restrictions does not affect the requirement of a special permit to be issued for some products by the competent services (in particular the central service for pharmaceutical products, the explosives department and the Coins and Medals Administration) in accordance with the provisions of the customs tariff.

The procedures outlined in the notices to importers published in the Journal Officiel on the dates mentioned hereunder shall be applicable to imports effected within the framework of the above liberalization measures, subject, where the case arises, to the special modalities referred to under the various titles of Annex II:

In accordance with present French regulations, assimilation to liqueur wines of certified origin is granted in favour of liqueur wines mentioned in the following provisions, enacted in pursuance of Article 12 of the Law of 6 May 1919 for the protection of certified origin:

- Decree of 1 July 1922 (Journal Officiel of 7 July 1922);
- Decree of 16 February 1938 (Journal Officiel of 19 and 25 February 1938);
- Decree of 26 May 1955 (Journal Officiel of 27 May 1955).

ANNEX II

1. General

It should be recalled that in general agricultural and food products imported within the framework of liberalization measures shall meet the requirements of French regulations from the points of view of technical specifications, health or plant health and fraud control.

2. Technical Visas

Import certificates for the products listed hereunder shall be visaed by the competent technical department to which they shall be sent directly with a pro forma invoice. The invoice visaed by the relevant department shall be submitted to the customs authorities together with the import certificate.

Where an application is submitted for an import licence or an advance permit, the necessary documents shall be issued automatically and unrestrictedly by the Service for trade (import) permits in the Department for Foreign Economic Relations, 8, rue de la Tour des Dames, Paris 9e, provided however, that the application has been visaed by the competent technical department. Applications shall be accompanied by a pro forma invoice. The Service for trade permits shall affix the usual date stamp to the invoice which shall be submitted to the customs authorities together with the green copy of the licence or advance permit as the case may be.
