TURKEY SCHEDULE - RENEGOTIATION

Extension of Decision of 22 August 1964

Decision of 1 November 1965¹

Considering that the CONTRACTING PARTIES, by Decision of 22 August 1964, suspended, subject to specified conditions, the application of the provisions of Article II of the General Agreement to the extent necessary to enable the Government of Turkey to modify concessions contained in Schedule XXXVII;

Considering that the Government of Turkey was required by the above-mentioned Decision to enter into negotiations and consultations with interested contracting parties and that negotiations were to be terminated by 31 October 1965;

Considering that although negotiations have been actively pursued, it will not be possible for the Turkish Government to conclude the negotiations with the remaining contracting parties by the date specified above;

Noting the Turkish Government's desire to complete the negotiations with all possible speed;

The CONTRACTING PARTIES, acting pursuant to the provisions of Article XXV:5 and in accordance with the procedures adopted by them on 1 November 1956,

Decide

- (a) that the negotiations referred to in paragraph 6 of the Decision of 22 August 1964 shall be allowed to continue until not later than the end of the next session of the CONTRACTING PARTIES; and
- (b) that the question of any further extension be reviewed at that session.
