FRANCO-GERMAN TREATY ON THE SAAR

Eighth Annual Reports (1965) Submitted by France and the Federal Republic of Germany

Under paragraph 5 of the Decision of 22 November 1957 (BISD 6S/50) the Governments of France and the Federal Republic of Germany are required to submit annual reports on measures taken by them in terms of the Decision. The following information relating to the special measures instituted in their trade relations with the Saar in 1964 has been furnished by the two Governments in two similar reports.

In 1964, these measures consisted in the mutual granting of tariff quotas which, on the basis of the trade relations in 1955, permitted on the one hand duty-free imports of French products into the Saar (List A) and on the other hand duty-free imports of goods from the Saar into France (List B).

The value of the French products imported into the Saar in 1964 within the frame of List A amounted to DM957 million corresponding to an utilization of about 62 per cent of the total amount of the quotas that have been opened. During the same year products from the Saar were imported into France within the frame of List B at a value of frs.655 million, corresponding to an utilization of about 62.5 per cent of the quotas.
