## ICELAND'S IMPORT RESTRICTIONS

### Modifications of Restrictions Effective 11 January 1967<sup>1</sup>

The Government of Iceland has notified the liberalization of imports valued in 1965 at IKr 132.4 million, or 2.2 per cent of total commodity imports in that year. Two commodities were also withdrawn from the free list at the same time, accounting for 0.5 per cent of imports in 1965. Global quotas, for imports from all free currency countries, were also announced. Details concerning these developments are given below.
