## GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

Notification by Australia
Addendum

In a communication dated 28 May 1982, the delegation of Australia notified the following changes in the GSP scheme of Australia for the information of contracting parties.

The Australian system of tariff preferences for developing countries (ASTP) was extended on 1 January 1981 to include most textile, clothing and footwear (TCF) items, as notified in L/3982/Add. 15 of 6 July 1981. As foreshadowed in that notification, these new arrangements were carried forward and applied to the new General Tariff structure for TCF products, which took effect from 1 January 1982.

Exclusions under the new TCF arrangements are based on the share of imports held by individual countries and are reviewed annually. Exclusions for calendar year 1983 are to be announced shortly.

In respect of general exclusions under the ASTP, the following modifications have been made since July 1981:
