GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

Notification by the United States

Addendum

Pursuant to the notification procedure under paragraph (c) of the Decision of the CONTRACTING PARTIES of 25 January 1971 concerning the Generalized System of Preferences, the delegation of the United States has provided the following information concerning recent modifications in the Generalized System of Preferences of the United States.

Attached for the information of contracting parties are Executive Order 12032 of 27 December 1977 and Executive Order 12041 of 25 February 1978 amending the United States GSP scheme.

Executive Order 12032 implements the results of the review which began in July 1977 with effect from 1 January 1978. Notably, the United States Government has added three products (TSUS 121.56, 732.35 and 745.62) to GSP, and in spite of requests for the removal of a number of products, no products were removed from GSP.

Executive Order 12041 implements, with effect from 1 March 1978, the results of the 1978 annual review of petitions seeking changes in the list of products eligible for GSP. The 1978 product review added 11 items¹ to the GSP list. Total trade in these items during 1977 was \$48.5 million with beneficiary developing countries accounting for approximately \$36.2 million of the total. There was a deletion of a portion of one item with negligible trade from the GSP list during the product review.

The Executive Order also implements changes in the GSP scheme required by the competitive need limitation provisions of the Trade Act of 1974 (Section 504(c)). These provisions (1) require the President to revoke within sixty days of the beginning of the calendar year the GSP eligibility of any country for a specific product if that country's exports of that product exceed certain ceilings during the preceding calendar year and (2) give the President discretionary authority to grant GSP eligibility for a product when a country's exports of that product fall below the ceiling.

The 1978 GSP product review resulted in the following changes in the United States GSP list. Annex II(a) to Executive Order 12041 indicates that some 115 products have been transferred from Annex II to Annex III. This means that certain beneficiary countries or territories, specified in Annex IV, are not eligible for GSP duty-free treatment for these items under the mandatory provisions regarding competitive need limitation, during the period 1 March 1978 to the end of February 1979. On the other hand, under the discretionary authority of the Trade Act, 121 products¹ (122 product/country groups) which had been ineligible for GSP for certain beneficiary countries or territories under competitive need during the year ending 28 February 1978 were redesignated as eligible for GSP for these countries and territories. Trade in these items during calendar year 1977 totalled \$152.7 million.

As a result of the modifications to the GSP list as referred to above, Annex III listing GSP items subject to competitive need limitation now includes 320 TSUS items. Of these 320 products, 314 are excluded from GSP duty-free treatment for only one country each, while six products are excluded for more than one supplier. Counting each country excluded from GSP on each particular product as one product/country group, there are a total of 342 product/country groups excluded (i.e. 314 product/country groups on the 314 products with only one country excluded, and the remainder on the six products with more than one country excluded). Imports of these products from excluded countries were \$3,049 million during calendar year 1977. In comparison, the 1977 product review resulted in 295 products being excluded under competitive need for one or more countries for a total of 318 product/country group exclusions with a total of 1976 calendar year trade of \$3,006 million.

Amending the Generalized System of Preferences

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the United States of America, including Title V and Section 604 of the Trade Act of 1974 (88 Stat. 2066, 19 U.S.C. 2461 *et seq.*; 88 Stat. 2073, 19 U.S.C. 2483), and as President of the United States of America, in order to modify, as provided by Section 504(c) of the Trade Act of 1974 (88 Stat. 2070, 19 U.S.C. 2464(c)), the limitations on preferential treatment for eligible articles from countries designated as beneficiary developing countries, and to adjust the original designation of eligible articles taking into account information and advice received in fulfillment of Sections 503(a) and 131-134 of the Trade Act of 1974, it is hereby ordered as follows:

SECTION 1. In order to subdivide existing items for purposes of the Generalized System of Preferences (GSP), the Tariff Schedules of the United States (TSUS) are modified as provided in Annex I, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SEC. 2. Annex II of Executive Order No. 11888 of November 24, 1975, as amended, listing articles that are eligible for benefits of the GSP when imported from any designated beneficiary developing country, is further amended as provided in Annex II, attached hereto and made a part hereof.


SEC. 3. Annex III of Executive Order No. 11888, as amended, listing articles that are eligible for benefits of the GSP when imported from all designated beneficiary countries except those specified in General Headnote 3(c) (iii) of the TSUS, is amended as provided in Annex III, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SEC. 4. General Headnote 3(c) (iii) of the TSUS, listing articles that are eligible for benefits of the GSP except when imported from the beneficiary countries listed opposite those articles, is amended as provided in Annex IV, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SEC. 5. (a) The amendment made by Annex IV, paragraph (a) of this Order with respect to item 613.18, TSUS, made part hereof by Section 4 above, shall be effective with respect to articles that are both: (1) imported on or after January 1, 1976, and (2) entered for consumption, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after March 1, 1977.

(b) The other amendments made by this Order shall be effective with respect to articles that are both: (1) imported on or after January 1, 1976, and (2) entered or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after January 1, 1978.


