## GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFFERENCES

## Notification by New Zealand

Addendum

For the information of contracting parties, the delegation of New Zealand hes provided details of changes to the New Zealand System of Generalized Preferences which entered into force on 1 July 1978 when a new customs tariff was introduced.

1. On 1 July 1978 New Zealand introduced a new customs tariff. Its overall effect was to reduce the number of tariff items and to reduce the rates of duty applicable to those items. The following statistical breakdown shows the effect of these reductions on the margins of preference accorded to developing countries.

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## Product coverage

2. Appendix A sets out details of the goods included in the New Zealand scheme with the duty rate applicable and the margin of preference accorded in each instance.
3. Brief indicative descriptions are siven in terms of the Customs Cooperation Council Nomencleture (CCCN) on which the New Zealand taripf is based. Matters of technical interpretation of the GSP will be determined, however, in accordance with the provisions of the New Zealand custoras tariff. This has repard to the fact that it has been devised on an individual tariff line besis.

Tariff-free treatment
4. It will be noted that in a significant number of cases, New Zealand has set the developing country rate at "Free".
5. It is also pertinent to bear in mind that in 669 tariff lines or over 25 per cent of the New Zealand customs tariff, MFN duty levels are set at "Free". (These details have not been incluced in Appendix A.)

## Exclusions from the scheme

6. Details of the limited number of items which have been excluded from the scheme for revenue or other special considerations: are listed in Appencix $B$.
7. These goods represent only some 8 per cent of the tariff lines in the new customs tariff.

## Rules of origin

8. The Customs Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 13, which took effect from 13 October 1978, replaced the former origin rules "wholly produced" and "wholly manufactured" categories with the single GSP "wholly obtained" category (amends Appendix C, Part B of L/4366/Add. 1 of 15 November 1976).
9. As a jesult of this amendment it has been necessary to amend the certificate of origin required in the case of goods for which preferential entry to New Zealand is sought. A copy of the revised text of the certificate (Form 59A) is attacied and will be required from 1 June 1979. (This replaces Certificate of Origin on page 78 of L/4366/Add.l of 15 November 1976.)

## Beneficiary countries

10. The following amendments should be made to Appendix $D$ of L/4366/Add. I:

Part A: Central African Republic should be Central African Empire.
China (Taiwan)* should be deleted and replaced with China (including that part known as Taiwan) - this is effective from 13 October 1978.

Pari C: French Territories of Afars and Issas are now known as Djibouti.
