For the information of contracting parties the delegation of Japan has notified in a communication dated 18 October the following improvements and modifications made in its GSP scheme for the 1982 fiscal year starting 1 April. 1

The amount of ceilings for GSP entry has been increased by 6.7 per cent in the 1982 fiscal year to $¥ 865,400$ million.
3. The Iist of LLDC beneficiaries

Guinea-Bissau has been included in the list. As a result, a total of 30 countries now enjoy the special preferential treatment for LLDCs under the Japanese GSP scheme.

[^1]:    IOn 1 April 1982, Japan put into force the two-year advanced implementation of Tokyo Round m.f.n. concessions across-the-board (cf. COM.TD/109). At the same time these GSP rates which had been higher than reduced m.f.n. rates were reduced to the level of m.f.n. duties.
