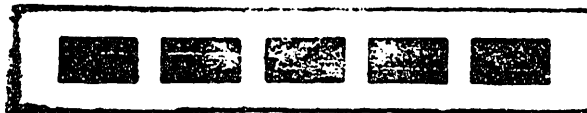

PAKISTAN - RENEGOTIATION OF SCHEDULE

Extension of Time-Limit

The following communication, dated 24 October 1979, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Pakistan.

The CONTRACTING PARTIES granted a waiver to Pakistan, under Article XXV:5 of the General Agreement, vide their decision of 29 November 1977^{1/}, to enable renegotiation of its Schedule of Concessions. The process of renegotiations was to be completed by 31 December 1979. It has however not been possible to complete this process so far, on account of the preoccupation of all the delegations at Geneva with the pressing business of Multilateral Trade Negotiations. It is accordingly requested that the CONTRACTING PARTIES may kindly grant an extension of this waiver for another year, up till 31 December 1980. Every endeavour will be made, in any case, to complete this process and to submit the consolidated revised Schedule of Concessions for Pakistan as soon as possible in the coming few months.
