EXTENSION OF TIME-LIMIT

The following joint communication, dated 26 October 1978, has been received from the Permanent Missions of the European Communities and Australia.

GATT document L/4659/Add.1 dated 10 August 1978 contains a communication from the delegations of Australia and of the European Communities agreeing that the ninety-day period set forth in Article XIX, paragraph 3(a) with respect to Australian Article XIX action on imports of wool worsted yarns would expire on 1 November 1978.

These consultations, however, could not be concluded within the period referred to above. Therefore the Governments of Australia and of the European Communities have agreed that their reciprocal rights and obligations under the General Agreement will be maintained and, for this purpose, have agreed that the ninety-day period set forth in Article XIX, paragraph 3(a) shall be considered to expire on 1 February 1979.
