EXTENSION OF TIME-LIMIT

The following joint communication, dated 19 January 1979, has been received from the Permanent Missions of the European Communities and Australia.

GATT document L/4659/Add.2 dated 2 November 1978 contains notification from the Government of Australia concerning actions under GATT Article XIX in respect of imports of wool worsted yarns.

The European Communities have engaged consultations with Australia pursuant to Article XIX.

These consultations, however, will not be concluded prior to the expiration of the ninety-day period provided in Article XIX, paragraph 3. Therefore, the Government of Australia and the European Communities have agreed that their reciprocal rights and obligations under the General Agreement will be maintained and for this purpose have agreed that the ninety-day period set forth in Article XIX, paragraph 3(a) shall be considered to expire on 1 May 1979.
