GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

Notification by Switzerland

The following communication dated 30 July 1979 has been received from the delegation of Switzerland.

I have pleasure in informing you that the Swiss Government has decided to include China among the beneficiary countries covered by the Swiss scheme of tariff preferences.

As from 30 July 1979, the Swiss scheme of tariff preferences as a whole will apply to China. However, as indicated in the attached text of the amendment dated 4 July 1979 to the Federal Council Ordinance determining preferential customs duties and the beneficiary countries thereof, certain exports from China to Switzerland will be subject to exceptions from the preferences. The products concerned are the following:

- heading No. 0704.10 and 0704.12 (mushrooms, garlic, tomatoes, onions)
 - : preference of 50 per cent

- sub-heading No. 3605.01 (pyrotechnic articles)

- : preference of 30 per cent
- chapters 50 to 64 (textile and textile articles, footwear)
- : no preference

ORDINANCE DETERMINING PREFERENTIAL CUSTOMS DUTIES AND THE BENEFICIARY COUNTRIES THEREOF

The Ordinance of 26 January 1972 determining preferential customs duties and the beneficiary countries thereof is hereby amended as follows:
