- 3. The Protocol has been accepted by the Dominican Republic and Egypt and signed, subject to ratification or ad referendum, by Chile, Israel, Ivory Coast and Zaire.
- 4. Two copies of the Protocol and the annexed schedules are being sent to each contracting party and to countries participating in the Multilateral Trade Negotiations not being contracting parties.
- 5. The printed volume containing the Protocol Supplementary to the Geneva (1979) Protocol and the annexed schedules will be ready in January 1980, at which time a certified copy of the Protocol will be transmitted to all contracting parties.
