TURKEY - STAMP DUTY

The following communication, dated 21 March 1980, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Turkey.

With reference to the decision of the CONTRACTING PARTIES of 27 November 1979 waiving the provisions of Article II:1 of the General Agreement to allow the Government of Turkey to maintain a stamp duty on imports of products included in Schedule XXXVII (document L/4893 of 30 November 1979), I have the honour to advise you that my Government, in the context of a set of measures - which will be the subject of a separate communication - designed to restore equilibrium and liberalize the Turkish economy, has reduced the rate of the said stamp duty from 25 per cent to 1 per cent under a governmental decree dated 24 January 1980.

Turkey had undertaken by the above-mentioned waiver decision of the CONTRACTING PARTIES to lower the rate of the stamp duty as circumstances permitted, and to report on progress in this respect. I request you, therefore, kindly to inform the contracting parties, in this context, of the current rate of stamp duty.
