Addendum

With reference to the Enabling Clause, the delegation of the United States has provided the following information regarding changes made in the United States GSP scheme with effect from 31 March 1983.

AMBASSADOR BROCK ANNOUNCES ANNUAL GSP CHANGES

(Press release dated 25 March 1983)

U.S. Trade Representative Bill Brock announced today that \$900 million in imports from advanced developing countries will not be eligible for duty-free treatment under the U.S. Generalized System of Preferences (GSP) due to discretionary graduation for the year beginning March 31, 1983.

The \$900 million in imports graduated under the President's discretionary authority represents a 38 percent increase over the \$651 million in products graduated in 1982, Ambassador Brock said.

Ambassador Brock said "a substantial number of products from advanced beneficiaries have been graduated from GSP eligibility during our last three annual reviews. It is clear from these reviews that several countries have become

sufficiently developed in certain product areas to compete effectively in the U.S. market without preferential treatment.

At present, decisions to graduate countries from GSP eligibility on various products are based on a country's level of development, its competitiveness in the specific product, and the overall economic interests of the United States, including the import sensitivity of the domestic industry.

In addition to the \$900 million in discretionary graduation, another \$7.1 billion in imports will be ineligible for duty-free treatment because of the "competitive need" limits (see attachments) specified in the Trade Act of 1974. Last year \$6.8 billion in beneficiary country trade was excluded because of these limits. In addition, three products with GSP trade valued at \$73 million are being removed from the program because of import sensitivity.

Ambassador Brock also announced that 29 new products will be eligible for duty-free treatment under the GSP program. In considering the addition of these products during the annual product review, careful consideration was given to the competitive position of U.S. producers likely to be affected by the changes. Roughly \$10 million in

developing country exports will benefit from product additions, compared to \$76 million in last year's review.

The Generalized System of Preferences is a program of unilateral tariff preferences granted by the United States to developing countries to assist in their economic development. Nineteen other industrialized countries also maintain GSP programs. At present, the United States grants duty-free treatment on approximately 3,000 products from 140 developing countries and territories. Since the program's implementation in 1976, the value of imports receiving GSP treatment has risen from \$3.0 billion to \$8.4 billion in 1982. GSP imports account for three percent of total U.S. imports.

An Executive order implementing changes in the GSP will be issued later this month. All changes will take effect on March 31. A fact sheet and product list are provided in the following pages.

The Trade Representative's Office also noted that the Administration would seek Congressional renewal this year of the GSP program which is scheduled to expire in January 1985.

SUMMARY OF GSP CHANGES

1. Changes Resulting from the 1982 GSP Product Review

The addition of new products to the GSP list.--As a result of the GSP product review, 29 new items are being designated for GSP duty-free treatment as of March 31, 1983. These items represent \$10 million in newly-eligible trade, compared to the \$76 million added in last year's review. The remaining 25 petitions under consideration in this year's review were denied, in most instances because of the import sensitivity of the domestic industry. In addition, the President has made a determination of "no domestic production" pursuant to section 504(c)(2)(d) with respect to two items already on the GSP list. This will allow Mexico and the Philippines to become eligible for GSP treatment on mescal (TSUS 169.46) and buri furniture (TSUS 727.12) respectively, despite the fact that the countries exceed the 50-percent competitive need limit on these articles. (See Annex I and Table 1)

The removal of items from the GSP.--Three articles are being removed from the GSP. U.S. imports of these articles from GSP beneficiary countries totaled \$73 million in 1982. Bolts (TSUS 646.54) and nuts (TSUS 646.56) are being removed pursuant to a petition filed by U.S. producers. High carbon ferromanganese (TSUS 606.30) is being removed pursuant to a review initiated by the Trade Policy Staff Committee in December 1982. Subsequent to its review of each of these cases, the interagency committee determined that GSP duty-free treatment was no longer warranted. This determination was made on the basis of the import sensitivity of the relevant domestic industries in the context of the GSP and the degree of competitiveness beneficiary developing countries have achieved with respect to these articles. (See Annex II and Table 2)

The removal, or "graduation," of a country from eligibility with respect to individual products.--Four countries--Korea, Mexico, Taiwan and Brazil--will be graduated from GSP eligibility on certain products in response to petitions filed by U.S. producers and labor unions. The graduation actions affect six of eight requests for limitation of GSP benefits under review. Excluded trade is valued at \$95 million, compared to the \$54 million similarly graduated last year. (See Annex III and Table 3)

2. Other Modifications

Redesignation of individual beneficiary developing countries for GSP benefits on specific items.--Individual countries previously excluded from receiving GSP duty-free treatment for particular products may be redesignated at the discretion of the President for GSP benefits if their 1982 shipments in individual items fell below last year's competitive need limits. Under this provision, developing countries are being redesignated for GSP duty-free treatment on 35 products valued at \$270 million, which represents 25 percent of the total amount of trade eligible for redesignation. The remaining 75 percent, or 50 items valued at \$805 million, are not being redesignated. In last year's redesignation exercise, imports valued at \$213 million were restored to GSP eligibility while \$597 million of beneficiary country trade was denied reinstatement. (See Annex IV and Table 4)

De minimis exemptions from the 50 percent competitive need provision.--A de minimis provision in the Trade Agreements Act of 1979 allows the President to waive the 50 percent competitive need limit in cases where total U.S. imports of an item in 1982 did not exceed \$1,266,622. As a result of the de minimis provision, imports of 206 products valued at \$47 million from individual beneficiaries will be exempt from the 50 percent competitive need rule. The value of trade benefiting from this provision last year was \$41 million. (See Annex V and Table 5)

The exclusion of exports of individual countries from GSP duty-free treatment for certain products because the competitive need ceilings were exceeded.--Under the statutory competitive need provisions, a country loses GSP duty-free treatment for a product if its shipments of a product in the preceding calendar year equaled or exceeded 50 percent of total U.S. imports of the product or were more than a certain dollar value (\$53.3 million for imports in 1982). Competitive need exclusions total \$7.1 billion based on 1982 trade, as compared to the \$6.8 billion affected by the statutory exclusions last year. (See Annex VI and Table 6)
