Corrigendum

Reply Nos 2,3 and 4 on page 1

In the third and fourth paragraphs, delete reference to "US \$10,000 f.o.b." and substitute "US \$500 f.o.b."

Reply No.7 on page 2

In the second paragraph, delete reference to "US \$10,000 f.o.b." and substitute "US \$3,000 f.o.b."

In the third paragraph, add a second sentence which reads:

"For the import certificates issued after 23 March, this period was reduced to 120 days."

Delete the fourth paragraph.

Reply No.12 on page 3

At the end of the paragraph add a phrase which reads:

"... which is offset against the applicable import duty."

Reply No.14 on page 3

Amend the reply to read:

"The period of validity of an import certificate is 120 days as from the date of issue. In duly justified cases, the Central Bank of Chile may extend the period of validity of an import certificate."
