NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF CONCESSIONS BY THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

Revision

The following communication, dated 29 October 1982, has been received from the delegation of the European Communities.

The European Communities and Canada have pursued further bilateral consultations in accordance with paragraph 2 of Article XIX on Article XIX measures taken by Canada on footwear (L/5263 and L/5351). These consultations have not led to a satisfactory solution.

In accordance with the procedures of paragraph 3 of Article XIX, therefore, the European Communities hereby give thirty days written notice to the contracting parties that they intend to suspend with regard to Canada concessions on the products on the list annexed. Unless further consultations lead to a mutually satisfactory agreement, the Community considers itself free to take such action on some or all of the products once the period of notice has expired.
