COMMUNICATION FROM FINLAND

Long-Term Trade Agreement between Finland and China

The following communication, dated 10 August 1983, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Finland.

The Permanent Mission of Finland has the honour to notify that a Long-Term Trade Agreement between the Government of the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Finland was signed on 11 June 1982 and entered into force on 1 January 1983. The Agreement was concluded for five years and will thereafter be automatically extended by one year at a time unless denounced in writing by either contracting party.

In accordance with the appropriate provisions of the Agreement, Finland eliminated on 1 January 1983 quantitative restrictions applied against the exports of China for products which are free of licence when imported to Finland from countries under multilateral treatment.
