STATUS OF ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

The Director-General has been informed by the Government of the United Kingdom, in a communication received on 21 September 1983, that the Islands of Antigua and Barbuda became independent (as a single entity) on 1 November 1981 under the name of Antigua and Barbuda.

Accordingly, the Recommendation of 11 November 1967 (BISD, Fifteenth Supplement, page 64), providing for the <u>de facto</u> application of the General Agreement as between the contracting parties and a territory which acquires autonomy, is applicable in respect of Antigua and Barbuda.
