AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY AND YUGOSLAVIA

Information Communicated by the Parties to the Agreement

This report covers the period subsequent to the year 1980.

The Co-operation Agreement between the European Economic Community and Yugoslavia, signed on 2 April 1980, entered into force on 1 April 1983.

The Agreement, whose trade provisions had been implemented in advance, has operated normally and in accordance with its provisions, as has the corresponding agreement concluded in respect of products within the coverage of the European Coal and Steel Community.

During this period the provisions of the Agreement have allowed a better balance to be achieved in trade between the Community and Yugoslavia.

A new system has been established for trade in textile products. This system, which covers the period 1983 to 1986 inclusively, provides for broader access than in the past to the Community market for textile products of Yugoslav origin, and opens Community access to products resulting from operations under outward processing arrangements.

Following the accession of Greece to the Community on 1 January 1981, the provisions of the Agreement have been extended to trade between that country and Yugoslavia. The additional protocol, signed on 1 April 1983, establishes the relevant special modalities.
