### Notification by Hungary

#### Addendum

The following communication dated 24 February 1984 has been received from the Permanent Mission of the Hungarian People's Republic for the information of contracting parties.

In accordance with the provisions of the Decision of Differential and More Favourable Treatment, Reciprocity and Fuller Participation of Developing Countries, I have the honour to communicate that Hungary has introduced further improvements in her General System of Preferences, as from 1 January 1984.

- by Decree No. 57/1983/XII.29./PM-KKM published in Official Gazette "Magyar Közlöny" No. 62. of 29 December 1983, Hungary has extended the general duty-free treatment of the least-developed countries to Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Sao Tome and Principe, Sierra Leone and Togo;
- by Decree No. 6/1983/XII.20./KKM-PM published in Foreign Trade Gazette "Külkereskedelmi Értesítő" No. 1. of 22 January 1984, Hungary has added the items indicated on page 2 to the list of products enjoying preferential tariff treatment in Hungary.
