## Changes in the Implementation of the Measure

#### Addendum

The following communication, dated 5 December 1984, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Canada.

The Government of Canada wishes to advise contracting parties of changes in the implementation of the measure concerning Canada's Article XIX action on leather footwear notified in document L/5351/Add.17 of 7 June 1984.

The extension of the quota is being shortened from the originally notified period of sixteen months to twelve months. The extension will therefore be in effect from 1 December 1984 to 30 November 1985.

The notification L/5351/Add.17 indicated that the global import quota for the period 1 December 1984 to 30 November 1985 would be increased by 3 per cent to 12.1 million pairs for leather footwear. This level has now been further increased for the same period to 12.3 million pairs (up 5.1 per cent over the previous twelve month period).
