## Notification by Finland

## Addendum

In a communication dated 25 June 1985, the delegation of Finland has notified the following improvements to its GSP scheme.

The following amendments took effect as on 1 May 1985.

- 1. Based on UN resolution 37/133, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Sao Tomé and Principe, Sierra Leone and Togo were included in the list of the least developed developing countries.
- 2. Hongkong was included in the list of beneficiaries. With regard to Hongkong, however, goods under the following CCCN headings remain subject to import duty, in addition to the general list of exclusions from GSP treatment:

- 3. The following new products were included in the Scheme in favour of all beneficiaries:
  - ex 03.01 red mullet (Mullus surmuletus, Mullus barbatus), bass (Morone labrax), gildhead (Sparus auratus), whole
  - ex 15.07 palm oil and coconut oil, unfit as such for human consumption
  - ex 20.05 jams, fruit jellies, marmalades, fruit purée and fruit pastes, of tropical fruits, whether or not containing added sugar.
- 4. Carpets with surface of jute and/or other textile bast fibres and/or manila hemp, or of sisal and/or other fibres of the agave family (ex 58.02) were included in the Scheme exclusively in favour of the least developed developing countries.
