NOTIFICATION IN PURSUANCE OF PARAGRAPH 3 OF THE UNDERSTANDING REGARDING NOTIFICATION, CONSULTATION, DISPUTE SETTLEMENT AND SURVEILLANCE

Communication from Uruguay

The following communication, dated 26 June 1985, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Uruguay.

I have the honour to inform you that having regard to the conjunctural situation which the National Treasury is currently experiencing, the Uruguayan Government has increased import duties by 5 percentage points with effect from 14 June and until 31 December 1986.

The minimum rate of duty is currently 15 per cent and the maximum 60 per cent. The decree excludes from the measure goods under "temporary admission", those which had already been exempted, precious metal coin, some agricultural inputs and products exempt from the minimum within the framework of LAIA.
