GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

Notification by Japan

Addendum

For the information of contracting parties the delegation of Japan has notified the following improvements and modifications made in its GSP scheme for the 1985 field year starting 1 April.

Improvements and modifications in the 1985 fiscal year

1. Increases in ceilings for GSP imports of industrial products

It may be recalled that for the last fiscal year GSP ceilings for industrial products were increased by as much as 55 per cent. For the 1985 fiscal year these ceilings have been further increased by approximately 100 billion yen (about 8 per cent). The total amount of ceilings for the year now exceeds 1,300 billion yen.

(1) with regard to items in respect of which imports are considered to present no particular difficulties to the domestic industries concerned, ceilings for respective product groups have been increased by 6 per cent, over and above the increase resulting from applications of the ceiling formulae notified last year (Cf. L/4531/Add.6). It may be noted that the extra increase of 6 per cent is a one-time action for the FY 1985.

<u>Ceiling for the FY 1985</u> = (total imports from preference-receiving countries in the FY 1982 plus 10 per cent of total imports from other sources in the FY 1983) multiplied by 1.06

(2) For three categories of sensitive items, to which the above formula is not to be applied, ceilings for respective product groups have been increased by 3 per cent as a one-time action, over and above the increase resulting from the application of the ceiling formulae notified last year.

*The specified coefficient to be stipulated by a cabinet order. The maximum of this coefficient is set at 0.06 or 6 per cent.

2. Reduction of GSP rates to zero for six SP items

The following 6 industrial products have been excluded from the SP** list, resulting in the elimination of positive GSP rates on these items.

**Items whose GSP tariff rates are one-half of MFN rates.

3. Revision of the special treatment for Least-Developed Countries

Ceiling limitations on duty-free treatment for least-developed countries on CCCN 57.10 (Woven fabrics of jute or of other textile bast fibres) have been eliminated. Thus, least-developed countries now can enjoy unlimited duty-free treatment on this item.
