ROSTER OF NON-GOVERNMENTAL PANELISTS

- 1. The CONTRACTING PARTIES decided at their fortieth session that "contracting parties should indicate to the Director-General the names of persons they think qualified to serve as panelists who are not presently affiliated with national administrations but who have a high degree of knowledge of international trade and experience of the GATT" and that "these names should be used to develop a short roster of panelists to be agreed upon by the CONTRACTING PARTIES in consultations with the Director-General" (BISD 315/9).
- 2. The first roster was agreed upon by the Council at its meeting in November 1985 (C/M/194). The Council agreed at its meeting in November 1986 to extend the roster for an additional year, i.e. until November 1987 (C/M/204). At its meeting in November 1987 (C/M/215), the Council agreed to extend the roster for a further year, with some amendments.
- 3. At its forty-fourth Session in November 1988 the CONTRACTING PARTIES decided to extend the Roster for another year. The Roster, as agreed by the CONTRACTING PARTIES, is reproduced hereunder:
