COMMITTEE ON ANTI-DUMPING PRACTICES

Meeting of 24, 25 and 27 October 1988

Note by the Chairman

- 1. The Committee held a regular meeting on 24, 25 and 27 October 1988 under the chairmanship of Mr. R.J. Arnott (Australia).
- 2. The Committee discussed anti-dumping laws and/or regulations of the EEC, Australia, New Zealand, Mexico, Brazil and Pakistan.
- 3. The Committee examined the semi-annual reports submitted by Parties to the Agreement on anti-dumping actions taken during the period 1 January-30 June 1988.
- 4. The Committee discussed a request by Japan for conciliation under Article 15:3 of the Agreement concerning Council Regulation (EEC) No. 1761/87 of 22 June 1987 and its application; the Committee took note of a request by the delegation of Sweden for the establishment of a panel under Article 15:5 of the Agreement in a dispute between Sweden and the United States concerning the imposition by the United States of anti-dumping duties on imports of certain stainless steel products from Sweden.
- 5. The Committee took note of statements made on anti-dumping duty investigations conducted by the EEC of imports of urea from various countries, anti-dumping duties applied by Australia on imports of power transformers from Finland and on the initiation of an anti-dumping duty investigation and imposition of provisional measures by Mexico with respect to imports of steel from EEC member States.
- 6. The Committee adopted its annual report to the CONTRACTING PARTIES (L/6423).
- 7. The next regular meeting of the Committee will take place in the week of 24 April 1989.
