## GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

### Notification by Poland

#### Addendum

In a communication dated 6 March 1989, the delegation of Poland has notified a revised GSP scheme of Poland which entered into force on 1 January 1989.

Pursuant to the paragraph 4(a) of the Decision of the Contracting Parties of 28 November 1979 concerning Differential and More Favourable Treatment, Reciprocity and Fuller Participation of Developing Countries, I have the honour to send you herewith to inform the Contracting Parties the Decree of the Minister of Foreign Economic Relations of 20 December 1988 concerning preferential rates of duty, together with the three following appendices thereto :

The above mentioned Decree entered into force as of 1 January 1989. It stipulates the establishment of the preferential zero rates of duty for commodities originating in 42 least developed countries as well as for 247 tropical products originating in other 87 developing countries. For all remaining products and for developing countries not being the least developed ones the preferential rates of duty are fixed at the level of 0.3 of the base MFN rate, established in the customs tariff.

The preferential rates of duty are to be applied to commodities imported directly from developing countries and transported directly from those countries and granted upon the presentation of a proper certificate of origin.

The principles and methods of drawing up and application of the certificates of origin are defined in the Appendix 2 to the Decree of the Minister of Foreign Economic Relations of 4 December 1989 concerning customs control and customs procedure /Journal of Laws No. 57, item 291 and of 1988, No.38, item 305/ and in the Agreement on uniform principles concerning the origin of goods from the developing countries for giving tariff preferences in the framework of the Generalized System of Preferences /Journal of Laws of 1982, No.15, item 116/. Other eligibility criteria concerning transportation and storage of goods remain unchanged.

The preferential treatment in the Polish GSP Scheme has thus been enlarged to cover all goods originating in 129 developing countries. It does not contain any specific restrictions or limitations.

The Government of Poland introduced the recent modifications in its GSP Scheme being firmly committed to the generally accepted principles and rules of international trade relations as set in the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, and intending to contribute further to liberalization efforts of the Contracting Parties and development of mutually advantageous economic relations with all countries, in particular developing ones.

Decree  
of the Minister of Foreign Economic Relations  
of 20 December 1988  
concerning preferential rates of duty

By virtue of paragraph 4 point 2 of the Decree of the Council of Ministers of 3 October 1988 concerning customs duties on commodities in commercial commodity turnover with abroad (Journal of Laws No. 35, item 271) it is hereby decreed as follows:

§ 1.1. The preferential zero rates of duty are established for commodities originating in the least developed countries among developing countries, specified in Appendix 1 to this Decree.

2. The preferential zero rates of duty are established for tropical products originating in other developing countries, specified in Appendix 2 to this Decree.

3. The preferential rates of duty are established amounting to 0.3 of the base MFN rate, established in the Customs Tariff on commodities imported in commercial commodity turnover with foreign countries, concerning commodities not specified in the list referred to in the Paragraph 1.2.

§ 2.1. The preferential rates of customs duty defined to in Paragraph 1 are to be applied to commodities imported directly from developing countries and transported directly from those countries and on the production of a proper certificate of origin.

2. The principles and methods of drawing up and application of the certificates of origin are defined in the Appendix 2 to the Decree of the Minister of Foreign Economic Relations

of 4 December 1984 concerning customs control and customs procedure (Journal of Laws No. 57, item 291 and of 1988, No. 38, item 305) and the Agreement on uniform principles concerning the origin of goods from the developing countries for giving tariff preferences in the framework of the Generalized System of Preferences (Journal of Laws of 1982, No. 15, item 116).

3. Commodities are considered to be imported directly if they are purchased in a firm registered in developing country being the preference-receiving country.

4. Commodities are considered to be transported directly if their transportation has even taken place through the territory of several countries due to geographical, transport, technical or economic reasons. The transported goods also comply with the rule of direct consignment even if they are temporarily stored in the territory of those countries, provided that the goods remain at all times under the transit countries customs control.

§ 3. This Decree enters into force on 1 January 1989.
