#### GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

#### Notification by Finland

#### Addendum

In a communication dated 27 April 1989, the Permanent Mission of Finland has transmitted the latest amendments to the Finnish Scheme for the Generalized System of Preferences. The amendments entered into force on 1 January 1989.

#### GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

#### Scheme of Finland

Amendments 1988/89

The Finnish scheme was adapted to the Harmonized System as from 1 January 1988. The application of the old rules of origin and the CCCN-based classification of goods as well as the use of old origin documentation is still allowed till the end of the year 1989.

In the adaptation of the rules of origin to the HS, the substance of the rules has been maintained unchanged. The basic rule concerning change of 4-digit heading for the acquisition of origin in respect of the import content will continue to be applied. (Decision of the Ministry of Finance No 595/88.)

A major change concerns presentation of the rules, ie., the introduction of a single list instead of lists A and B. The list indicates all cases where the basic principle of the change of heading does not apply, or does so only under certain conditions, or where special requirements have been set out for the acquisition of origin. Introductory notes have been added to the list. The list of working or processing required to be carried out on non-originating materials in order that the product manufactured can obtain originating status is described in Annex I.

The Decree (No. 974/71) on the preferential treatment of goods imported from developing countries has been last amended by Decree No. 1064/88 which entered into force on 1 January 1989 (Annex II).

Few amendments have been made to the list of the preference receiving countries in 1 §. Macao was included in the scheme as from 1 January 1988. The Netherlands Antilles were included as from 1 January 1989 and at the same time the status of Burma was changed to that of a least developed country.

The coverage of the product lists given in 2-4 §§ was maintained unchanged when the new HS Nomenclature was adopted. As from 1 January 1989 after the conversion to the HS nomenclature 30 items having minor commercial value to trade were, however, deleted from the list of products not eligible for the GSP treatment. Two more items were added to the list concerning the products of the least developed countries.
