RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTS FROM ROMANIA

Notifications by Contracting Parties

In airgram GATT/AIR/2882 of 15 November 1989, contracting parties were invited to notify by 31 March 1990, in accordance with paragraph 3(b) of the Protocol for the Accession of Romania, discriminatory prohibitions and quantitative restrictions still applied to imports from Romania.

AUSTRIA

With reference to GATT/AIR/2882 of 15 November 1989 I have the honour to inform you that Austria does not apply any discriminatory prohibitions and quantitative restrictions to imports from Romania.

JAPAN

With reference to GATT/AIR/2882, I wish to notify that Japan does not maintain any discriminatory prohibitions or quantitative restrictions on imports from Romania.

POLAND

Referring to the airgram GATT/AIR/2882 I wish to state that Poland does not apply any discriminatory prohibitions or restrictions to imports from Romania.

SWITZERLAND

With reference to your circular GATT/AIR/2882 of 15 November 1989 concerning restrictions on imports from Romania, we have the honour to communicate the following with regard to our import regime:

1. Industrial products

Under the arrangements for the facilitation of mutual trade, imports into Switzerland of industrial products (finished, semi-finished and basic products) from Romania are not subject to any quantitative restrictions.

2. Agricultural products

Imports of agricultural products from Romania are subject to the same regime as imports from all other countries.

Consequently, Switzerland does not apply any discriminatory quantitative restrictions to Romania.

TURKEY

With reference to GATT/AIR/2882 of 15 November 1989, I have been instructed by my Government to inform you that Turkey does not apply any discriminatory restrictions to imports from Romania.
