Outline of system

1. In 1977, Sri Lanka liberalized most of her non-tariff measures. However, a selected group of products require import licences.

Purposes and coverage of the licensing

2. The purpose of the licensing is basically three-fold, namely:

- (i) to protect local industries;
- (ii) to allocate foreign exchange; and
- (iii) to administer import restrictions.

Some of the essential items are under licence in order to ensure regular supplies. Some items, such as motor vehicles, are under licence in order to control imports. A list of the items under licence is annexed.

3. The system applies to goods originating in, and coming from, all countries. However, trade with Taiwan and Israel is disallowed for the public sector organizations in Sri Lanka.

4. No. As indicated at 2 above.

5. Imports and Exports Control Act No.1 of 1969 and subsequent amendments. Under the Act, the Government has the power to prohibit or restrict the importation of any goods and prescribe any conditions relating to imports and exports. The import and export control policy is formulated by the Ministry of Trade and Commerce in consultation with the Ministry of Finance. The Minister of Trade and Commerce is empowered under the Act to issue regulations in conformity with the object and purposes of the Act. The responsibility of administering the regulations vests with the Imports and Exports Control Department.

Procedures

8. The Controller of Imports and Exports can refuse a licence to any applicant without adducing reasons. The applicant has the right to appeal to the Minister concerned in the event of refusal. However, licences are issued in almost all cases of applications, which meet statutory requirements.

Eligibility of importers to apply for licence

9. Yes, as long as statutory requirements are met by the concerned parties.

12. A fee of 10 per cent is charged for a licence issued to anyone who pays income tax. A fee of 15 per cent is charged for a licence issued to a person for importing goods donated by a family member resident abroad.
