The Corporation has the sole right to import wheat, rye, barley, oats and meal products of these grains. There is also an obligation to purchase domestic grain and to maintain sufficient stocks. The mechanism works similarly with regard to concentrates. Norway imports approximately 96 per cent of the grain used.
