SPAIN

Explanatory Notes

- 1. The products subject to the various restrictions in force as of 31.5.1973 are shown in the list and arranged by their respective BTN numbers.
- 2. Countries (or group of countries) which have indicated an interest: Australia, EEC, New Zealand, United States.
- 3. Type of restrictions:
- GQ, DL: Global régime. Under this system, imports coming from OECD or assimilated countries are subject to prior authorization, regulated in advance by the administration, which determines the conditions that candidates must fulfill in order to participate in the allocation of overall quotas.
- DL: Bilateral trade. Imports are subject to prior authorization, granted on a discretionary basis by the Administration. This system covers all goods coming from countries which are not members of OECD or assimilated thereto and goods not coming under the free imports, global régime or State-trading systems.
- ST: State trading. Foodstuffs and alcohol are generally imported through the Commissariat General of Supply and Transport, a body responsible to the Ministry of Trade. Imports of tobacco are carried out by Tabacalera SA, the tobacco monopoly.
- * Transitional régime. The products are submitted to the trade régime indicated until a decision is reached on the import regulating régime to be applied.
- BQ (CEE): Quotas for imports from the European Economic Community. Except for BTN No 04.02 these quotas re increased periodically. For the following products, under normal market conditions, the share of imports from the Community is to be maintained: BTN Nos 01.02 B2, 01.03 B, 01.05 A-3-b, B-2-b, 02.01, 02.02, 02.03, 02.04, 02.05, 02.06, 04.01, 04.05 B and C, 08.01 A, 08.06, 08.07, 09.01 A, 10.01 B, 10.02 B, 10.03 B, 10.04 B, 10.05 B, 10.06, 10.07 B-2, 11.01, 11.02, 11.04, 12.01 B 1 and B 4, 12.02 A and B, 12.06, 12.08 A, 15.01, 15.0 C, 15.07 A, 15.13, 17.01 B, 17.03, 21.07 D, 22.04, 22.05, 23.07 A.
- 4. Spain has bilateral agreements with the German Democratic Republic, Colombia and Equatorial Guinea.
