#### TUNISIA

### (a) Global quotas (G.Q.)

The products affected by this measure are in general sensitive products that are current consumer items; the volume of imports is fixed annually having regard to national requirements.

#### (b) Bilateral quotas

These are quotes fixed within the framework of agreements which Tunisia concludes each year with other countries; they are of a purely indicative character and are implemented in a very flexible way. The list of these products varies from one agreement to another.

### (c) Monopolies (M)

The products in respect of which an import monopoly is entrusted to State or private bodies are in principle essential products any shortage of which must be avoided. The monopoly also covers products of public health interest. Products under monopoly or global quota are listed on pages 2-3.

## (d) <u>Import licence or transfer permit</u>

Imports of all other products except those listed on pages 4-5 are subject to transfer permit or import licence, depending on whether the products originate in and are imported from the franc area or another currency area. In principle these two documents are granted systematically.

The products listed on pages 4-5 are imported under a simple import certificate issued immediately by approved intermediary banks.
