All agricultural products other than those listed below are subject to the prior deposit requirements and, for this purpose, are divided into six commodity lists:

<u>List</u>	<u>Deposit requirement</u>
F - 50/1	70%
F - 50/2	59%
F - 50/3	42%
F - 100/1	140%
F - 100/2	119%
F - 100/3	84%

Lists F - 50/2, 50/3, 100/2 and 100/3 are being reduced gradually in line with the Association Agreement with the EEC providing for the elimination of prior deposit requirements. Although the Agreement requires liberalization only with regard to EEC countries, Greece has extended these reductions on a multilateral, most-favoured-nation basis. No reductions are scheduled for lists F - 50/1 and F - 100/1.
